Pennsylvania PROVIDING UPSKILLING IN COUNTY JAILS & JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTERS

After serving as a training option for unemployed or underemployed jobseekers during the COVID-19 pandemic, Metrix Learning received extended access to serve the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's adult and youth re-entry populations, both pre- and postrelease.

Metrix Learning provides training across the state in:

- Secure correctional facilities
- County jails
- Juvenile justice centers

Incarcerated Pennsylvanians take training courses at no cost to the learner, gaining the employability skills that employers indicated were most crucial for on-the-job success in a 2023 statewide survey.

Our device-agnostic, cloud-based Learning Management System can restrict what learners can see and turn off all external links and supplementary features for use in secure correctional facilities. A learner account initially set up in the restricted "Lockdown Mode" can be changed to standard mode post-release **so justice-impacted individuals can continue upskilling** and access their Certificates of Completion for courses completed during incarceration.

Texas CERTIFICATIONS TO EXPAND JOB PROSPECTS STATEWIDE

In addition to providing no-cost access to 7,000 courses in Metrix Learning to any WIOA-eligible Texan, the Texas Workforce Commission launched a program to sponsor the cost of certification exams for qualified individuals who complete training courses to prepare for their exams.

Metrix Learning equips students to successfully pass over 130 industry-recognized certification exams. Training is delivered in a self-paced, online format that's available 24/7 to suit any learner's lifestyle. In career fields that value certifications, they carry a significant salary premium (as much as 18%!) and help boost job prospects or pave the way for moving up the career ladder.

Through the case-managed certification program, Metrix Learning helps approved Texans with:

- Dedicated staff to walk them through the process
- Practice exams
- Scheduling for certification exams

Learners can take exams in person at an authorized testing center or online with the proctored online exam option. Since the certification program launched in 2021, hundreds of Texans have benefited from an industry certification that verifies their skills.





New Jersey REACHING ACROSS COMMUNITIES -INCUMBENT WORKERS, YOUTH, & MORE

SkillUp New Jersey, a program bringing professional job training courses to residents across the Garden State, has focused on upskilling both jobseekers and their communities.

No cost-access to Metrix learning is available to community partners like:

In addition, medium employers can take advantage of deeply discounted access to Incumbent Worker Training programs. These community partners can customize the courses assigned to their learners and monitor progress. **Programs like the Summer Youth Employment Program have successfully used Metrix Learning courses and game-based learning to develop essential work-readiness skills.** Remote education and enrichment activities throughout the summer give students the skills to be successful during their summer assignment and beyond.

Public assistance recipients in the WorkFirstNJ program can build job skills in a hybrid learning model to prepare them to enter the workforce successfully. Instructors help participants work through courses, discuss what they've learned, and apply their knowledge and skills to the working world.



Oregon CAREER READINESS FOR SNAP PARTICIPANTS

After the pandemic, Oregon had a partial waiver through the U.S. Department of Agriculture for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) participants classified as Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWD). That meant SNAP recipients in some counties were now required to meet monthly hour requirements for job searching and training.

Oregon needed a solution to provide job training to ABAWD participants in counties without a waiver. Metrix Learning was already assisting learners within the state, so it formally launched a program for ABAWD participants in July 2021.
